- * Visual Disabilities

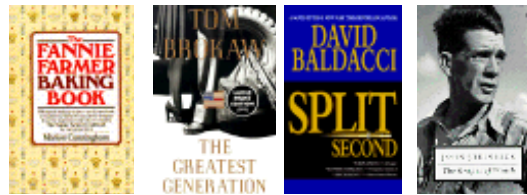
Benefits of Homebound Services

How Do I Know I Will Get Materials That I Enjoy?

Before bringing materials to your home a member of the library staff will call to schedule a home or phone interview. At our first meeting we will discuss areas of interest which will help us better understand what types of authors, and books you prefer or any other information that may be helpful.

When Will You Be Visiting?

Once we have established what you would like we will schedule a time to come to your home to drop off the materials. Midway through your loaning period a library staff member will contact you to see what items you may be interested in when we visit next.

How Long May I Borrow The Items I Take Out?

The lending period for all items through the Homebound program is 4 weeks. You can renew your materials once as long as no other patrons are waiting for them.
